

# NORTHPOINT EXPEDITIONARY LEARNING ACADEMY ON-SITE LEARNING PROGRAM (OSLP)

In accordance with EO 2020-51, Northpoint will provide an on-site safe learning option to high need students during physical closure during the 2020-2021 school year. Please read the following on-site program procedures and considerations.

## **On-Site School Procedures and Considerations**

- I. Before Coming to Campus:
  - A. Contact Wendy Gregory at 928-717-3272 or [wendygregory@northpointacademy.org](mailto:wendygregory@northpointacademy.org) to confirm eligibility for and space in this program.
    1. Make sure your student is healthy and ready for school.
- II. Entering School during physical closure
  - A. Students will be let in the front doors by the office with proper spacing and facemasks. Please don't cluster too much before school.
    1. Students may enter the building at 8:55 and at 12:00, so they have time to log in to their courses.
    2. If ESS staff observes students need more time for logging in, then we will move our entry to an earlier time.
    3. Wearing face coverings is required by every student, staff, and visitor to any Arizona school.
- III. Starting Distance Learning Courses
  - A. Students must complete Ground School before entering the academic classes.
  - B. Ground School is a set of activities designed to ensure the online skills necessary to participate in Northpoint's Google/Zoom Classrooms.
    1. Ground School may be provided by staff other than ESS.
    2. ESS staff will monitor the proper spacing, assist students with technical issues.
    3. Report any On-site learners' technical issues to Wendy Gregory.
- IV. Daily Schedule: OSLP School
  - A. Students will follow the same schedule for breaks and lunch as the distance learning school.
    1. The synchronous schedule allows for a level of normalcy, inside of the switch to online courses.
    2. Following the schedule ensures our best efforts to follow the inclusion model, so that ESS/504 students are active IN the classroom, with extra supports.
- V. Student expectations:

- A. Students are expected to arrive on time, be healthy, and be ready for the school day.
  - B. Students are expected to engage in the online platform, independently much of the time, but with support provided by ESS Staff.
  - C. Students are expected to communicate with teachers via email.
- VI. Leaving online school sessions:
- A. Students may attend a morning or afternoon session
    - a. Students may leave with parents at 12:00 pm or at 3:00 pm to avoid loss of class time.
- VII. On-Site Learning Program supervision:
- A. Students will be supervised during school hours, including breaks and lunch. ESS staff will assist students with Zoom session and Google Classroom work.
- VII. Limited Space Available:
- A. Northpoint ESS staff can serve up to 35 IEP/504 students at this current time. Please contact [Wendygregory@northpointacademy.org](mailto:Wendygregory@northpointacademy.org), (928)717-3272.
  - B. If the number of requests for this service exceeds the number of spaces that are available, we will develop a rotating system to ensure equity.
